

- » Steps combined with sloped grades help to traverse the terrain
- » Existing trail realigned to better accommodate grade changes and prevent continued erosion
- » Limestone steps transition to natural stone blocks as the final overlook approaches
- » Boulders interspersed with prairie grasses frame the first two vistas, providing a visual edge without requiring railings
- A circle of limestone blocks defines the final overlook. This area is held back
 slightly from the cliff edge, so there's no immediate drop below
