

Ordinance No. 164, Fourth Series

An Ordinance Repealing Interim Ordinance No. 156

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 462.355, on November 23, 2020, the City Council adopted Interim Ordinance No. 156, An Interim Ordinance Creating a Moratorium for Conditional Use Permits for Multiple Family Residential (5+ Units) as Part of a PUD Involving the Reuse of an Existing Institutional/Commercial Building Within the City of Red Wing; and

WHEREAS, the moratorium created by Interim Ordinance No. 156 allowed the City sufficient time to review the City’s Ordinance, including Division 47-060, and was effective for one year unless earlier terminated by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City has completed its review of the Zoning Ordinance and, effective May 10, 2021, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 162, An Ordinance Amending Chapter 11 of the Red Wing City Code, which revised Division 47-060; and

WHEREAS, Interim Ordinance No. 156 is no longer necessary to protect the planning process and health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED WING DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: Interim Ordinance No. 156, An Interim Ordinance Creating a Moratorium for Conditional Use Permits for Multiple Family Residential (5+ Units) as Part of a PUD Involving the Reuse of an Existing Institutional/Commercial Building Within the City of Red Wing, is repealed in whole.
