

## <u>NOTES:</u>

- 1. TYPE B APPROACH ALLOWED ONLY IN COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL AREAS. VALLEY GUTTERS (PLATE NO. 3-07) ARE ALSO ALLOWED FOR COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL APPROACHES.
- 2. CONTRACTION JOINTS SHALL PROJECT STRAIGHT THROUGH NEW CURB, DRIVE APRON, AND WALK. WHEN CONTRACTION JOINTS ARE FORCED TO BE OFFSET DUE TO EXISTING WALK AND/OR CURB, PROVIDE 1/2" EXPANSION JOINT(S) AS DIRECTED BY ENGINEER.
- (3) PROVIDE CONTRACTION JOINT(S) EQUALLY SPACED.

  NO LESS THAN 6 FT. AND NO MORE THAN 10'. AS MEASURED ALONG "L"
- (4) TRANSVERSE CONTRACTION JOINT REQUIRED WHEN "D"=10' OR GREATER, PLACED AT THE CENTER OF THE APPROACH.
- (5) PROVIDE CONTRACTION JOINT AS SHOWN, CONTRACTION JOINT SHALL MEET BACK OF CURB AT THE MIDPOINT OF THE RADIUS
- 6 PROVIDE 1/2" EXPANSION JOINT
- ${f ilde{ extstyle 7}}$  to ensure ada requirements sidewalk shall be cast separately from drive apron.
- 8 CURB MAY CONTINUE AND MATCH PARKING LOT CURB PROVIDED PEDESTRIAN RAMPS MEETING PARKING LOT CURB PROVIDED PEDESTRIAN RAMPS, WITHOUT TRUNCATED DOMES.
- 9. CONCRETE TO BE CONSTRUCTED ON PROPERLY COMPACTED BASE.
